ROADWAY: Glen Rd.

**SPEED SURVEY** 

**OCTBER 2019** 

**INITIAL COMPLAINT**: The Traffic Safety Unit conducted this survey based on a complaint from a resident.

<u>DESCRIPTION OF AREA</u>: Glen Rd. is a two lane roadway posted at 25 MPH. It has one northbound and one southbound lane. It intersects Harte Rd. to the north and Hilltop Rd. to the south. It is located in the Jenkintown section of Abington Township. There are residential homes on the east and west side of the street.

**INFORMATION GATHERING METHOD**: The speed survey was conducted using a RADAR TRAFFIC COUNTER. The counter is attached to a pole and uses radar to record traffic volume and speed data. Crash data was obtained from the closest intersections (Harte Rd. and Hilltop Rd.) for the past 5 years. There were no reported crashes at either intersection or on Glen Rd. during the past 5 years.

<u>FACTORS</u>: The speed of the vehicles using this section of Glen Rd. showed that 0.0 % of the traffic met the criteria for enforcement. The 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed for this section of Glen Rd. was 29 MPH. 3428 vehicles were monitored in the survey.

**ANALYSIS**: At this time speeding does not seem to be an issue on this section of Glen Rd. The average speed was 18 MPH. Based on the analysis the roadway appears to be posted appropriately.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**: The Traffic Safety Unit will continue to monitor the area with high visibility traffic enforcement activity.
